

MPD Alarm Ordinance Unit Payment Methods

The fees are set in the City of Miami Burglary & Robbery Alarm Ordinance, Section 3-23

The Alarm Unit wishes to inform you that if your permit is not in police response and you wish to have this changed as quickly as possible, submit your payment in person.

The Alarm Ordinance Unit and the City of Miami Finance Department provides the following manners in which to submit payment for any or all False Alarm and Renewal invoices.

CITY OF MIAMI ONLINE PAYMENT

You will need to have your Oracle customer number and an invoice number to successfully log in. These can both be located on a city generated invoice.

IN PERSON

At the Alarm Ordinance Unit located in the Miami Police Department. Payment can be made using cash, money order, check or credit card (Visa or MasterCard). The address is:
